508. Report from Cllr. Dennis about CCTV for the Parish Hall Area discussions with Mr. Higgins the garage owner.

Cllr. Dennis stated that the suggestion from the garage owner was to place the CCTV cameras up on the Parish Hall premises behind glass, images might not be good enough to recognise people.

Mr. Higgins has not been able to join the meeting. It is felt it should be controlled by the Parish Council. Parish Council will look into this. Beregen and Y. 2 Y. are in favour.

Cllr. Dennis stated that CCTV has improved since I investigated it last year.

As to cost it depends on whether we need just one.

Legal situation a nominated person to look at images.

Cllr. Lamb stated that the Police Commissioner has funds for CCTV in the Devon Area.

Cllr. Lamb stated that he had investigated our insurance re-newel; we need to get two additional quotes. The Clerk explained that we have a five year contract and this next year will be our last one.

Cllr. Lamb stated that the lift accident might be covered by our insurance he would like to contact them and explain the situation.
